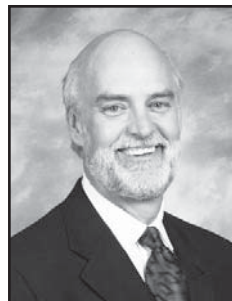
Scout Sunday
