## Unit 4 — Satan

### Lesson 3 — Temptation comes from Satan, the world and our sin nature.

#### Introduction —

Tell your children about the three big enemies that will try to make them veer off the path to real life.

“The world” approaches us in many forms:

a friend who suggests that we cheat on a test or experiment with drugs

a school textbook that tells lies about history or religion or science

a music CD with lyrics that tempt us to mistreat our teachers, parents or friends

a movie or TV show that condones bad behavior


“The flesh” goes back to what we taught our kids earlier: [We tend toward evil](#). Since we are descendants of Adam, we already are inclined to give into evil thoughts and ways.

“The devil” we already discussed in [Unit 4, Lesson 1](#). Satan is real. And though he has been defeated by Jesus’ death and resurrection, he is still dangerous for now.

##### Fast Ask:

Give examples from the Bible of people who didn't resist Satan. What should they have done?
