## Unit 5 — Jesus

### Lesson 2 — He became a human, lived a perfect life and gave His life as payment for our sin.


**Introduction** — As part of the Trinity, Jesus has existed for all eternity. But on the first Christmas He became one of us (for real, not just in appearance) and will now be one with us forever. Unlike the rest of us, He is a perfect human being. He has never done wrong; He has never disobeyed our Father in heaven. So when He died in our place, He was the perfect sacrifice.

We may never understand exactly how and why Jesus' death solved the problem of our sin. We just know from the Bible and from experience that in Christ our relationship with God is and will be fully restored.

When you teach your kids these incredible truths, don't aim to make them grasp everything with their minds. It's better to help them *feel the impact* by watching a film or hearing a story where the hero gives up his life to save others (such as Aslan in C.S. Lewis' *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*).
